



# Corporate/Group Missions

Challenger Learning Center of Kansas offers a unique hands-on program designed to promote team-work, problem solving, decision-making and communication skills. Team members will perform tasks and face the same challenges as real NASA astronauts, scientists and engineers. The core activity is a two-hour space simulation program that takes place in state-of-the-art space simulation environments, including a Space Station and a Mission Control center modeled after NASA's Johnson Space Center. This mission experience is designed for groups of 14 to 32 participants. It can also bring with it the use of a meeting room in the center for an hour before or after you mission. This team building experience takes your team out of the normal work environment and places them in an unusual situation. In this dynamic environment, peoples' natural habits and methods become apparent.
